Greater Geelong Planning Scheme Amendment C395: Settlement Strategy and Northern and Western Growth Areas Framework Plan

The Panel makes the following directions in relation to the Hearing of retail matters in the reconvened C395 Hearing in March.

1. After closing on the broader Amendment on Friday 14 February 2020 as scheduled, the Panel will reconvene in Melbourne at Planning Panels Victoria on **Monday 16 and Wednesday 18 March 2020**.
2. On Monday 16 March 2020 the Panel will hear the evidence of Mr McNeil for the McCann Family (evidence already circulated) and other submitters as confirmed by the Panel interested in the retail matters in the C393 Amendment said to be relevant to Amendment C395.
3. In accordance with Council's direction under Section 24(e) of the *Planning and Environment Act 1987*, (see Tabled Document 209) the Panel will also hear on the 16 March 2020 from the Perez Family in relation to Leopold.
4. On Wednesday 18 March 2020 the Panel will hear submissions and evidence from Lascorp followed by a brief reply from Council.
5. Lascorp's evidence (as previously identified and shown on the timetable) must be circulated to the distribution list by **4.00pm on Monday 2 March 2020**.
6. All parties to the reconvened Hearing must circulate their written submissions by **4.00pm on Tuesday 10 March 2020**, excepting Council who will only provide a brief closing.
