<p><b>56.02-1</b> STRATEGIC IMPLEMENTATION OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To ensure that the layout and design of a subdivision is consistent with and implements any objective, policy, strategy or plan for the area set out in this scheme.</p>	<p>Complies – The proposal is consistent with all relevant objectives, policies, strategies and plans as outlined in the Planning Report including the Leopold Structure Plan.</p>
<p><b>56.03-4</b> BUILT ENVIRONMENT OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To create urban places with identity and character.</p>	<p>Complies – The development will be similar in style and appearance to other recently subdivided parcels within the vicinity. The development will provide for made road, kerb and channel, footpaths and underground power.</p>
<p><b>56.04-1</b> LOT DIVERSITY AND DISTRIBUTION OBJECTIVES</p> <p>To achieve housing densities that support compact and walkable neighbourhoods and the efficient provision of public transport services.</p> <p>To provide higher housing densities within walking distance of neighbourhood centres.</p> <p>To achieve increased housing densities in designated growth areas.</p> <p>To provide a range of lot sizes to suit a variety of dwelling and household types.</p>	<p>Complies – Lot sizes vary providing housing diversity and choice.</p> <p>Lots are appropriately orientated and are of adequate size to allow for the construction of dwellings and associated outbuildings. Lots are reasonably accessible to all required facilities such as public transport, neighbourhood centres and the like.</p>
<p><b>56.04-2</b> LOT AREA AND BUILDING ENVELOPES OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To provide lots with areas and dimensions that enable the appropriate siting and construction of a dwelling, solar access, private open space, vehicle access and parking, water management, easements and the retention of significant vegetation and site features.</p>	<p>Complies – Lots range in area from 325m<sup>2</sup> to 672m<sup>2</sup> and are suitably dimensioned to allow for the construction of future dwellings.</p>
<p><b>56.04-3</b> SOLAR ORIENTATION OF LOTS OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To provide good solar orientation of lots and solar access for future dwellings.</p>	<p>Complies – Lots are appropriately orientated to maximise solar efficiency.</p>

<p><b>56.05-1</b> INTEGRATED URBAN LANDSCAPE OBJECTIVES</p> <p>To provide attractive and continuous landscaping in streets and public open spaces that contribute to the character and identity of new neighbourhoods and urban places or to existing or preferred neighbourhood character in existing urban areas.</p> <p>To incorporate natural and cultural features in the design of streets and public open space where appropriate.</p> <p>To protect and enhance native habitat and discourage the planting and spread of noxious weeds.</p> <p>To provide for integrated water management systems and contribute to drinking water conservation.</p>	<p>Complies – Street planting will be undertaken in accordance with current Council Policy using species native to the area which will be of appropriate height and width once mature.</p>
<p><b>56.05-2</b> PUBLIC OPEN SPACE PROVISION OBJECTIVES</p> <p>To provide a variety of open spaces with links to other open spaces and regional parks where possible.</p> <p>To ensure that public open space of appropriate quality and quantity is provided in convenient locations to meet the recreational and social needs of the community.</p> <p>To support active and healthy communities.</p>	<p>Complies – Two reserves are proposed which are located along the western boundary of the site. The reserve located in the north west corner of the site also contains a wetland basin. The reserves are for the purposes of municipal drainage and pipelines.</p>

Footpaths will be constructed, as required, in accordance with Council requirements and specifications.</p>
<p><b>56.06-4</b> NEIGHBOURHOOD STREET NETWORK OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To provide for direct, safe and easy movement through and between neighbourhoods for pedestrians, cyclists, public transport and other motor vehicles using the neighbourhood street network.</p>	<p>Complies – Provision has been made for road connection to existing and proposed road network at Melaluka Road. Footpaths will be constructed, as required, in accordance with Council requirements and specifications.</p>

<p><b>56.07-2</b> REUSED AND RECYCLED WATER OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To provide for the substitution of drinking water for non-drinking purposes with reused and recycled water.</p>	<p>N/A – The use of recycled water is not proposed as part of this development.</p>
<p><b>56.07-3</b> WASTE WATER MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To provide a waste water system that is adequate for the maintenance of public health and the management of effluent in an environmentally friendly manner.</p>	<p>Complies – The site will be connected to a reticulated waste water system to the requirements of the relevant Water Authority.</p>

Materials will be reused and recycled where appropriate.</p>

<p><b>56.09-3</b> FIRE HYDRANTS OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To provide fire hydrants and fire plugs in positions that enable fire fighters to access water safely, effectively and efficiently.</p>	<p>Complies – Fire hydrant/s will be provided to the requirements as specified by the CFA.</p>
<p><b>56.09-4</b> PUBLIC LIGHTING OBJECTIVE</p> <p>To provide public lighting to ensure the safety of pedestrians, cyclists and vehicles.</p> <p>To provide pedestrians with a sense of personal safety at night.</p> <p>To contribute to reducing greenhouse gas emissions and to saving energy.</p>	<p>Complies – Street lighting will be provided to the relevant Council specifications.</p>
